Directions for use

For professional use only.

- 1. Clean the floor to be stripped. It is recommended that sections are used, to avoid walking over treated areas.
- 2. Dilute 125ml product per L of either hot or cold water (12.5%). Apply to the floor liberally with either mop or sprayer.
 - Always test an inconspicuous area before use. Some types of linoleum and rubber are susceptible to colour change. Test for colour fastness before use.
- 3. Leave the solution to sit from between 3-5 minutes, softening the polish.
- 4. Apply more hot water, then scrub the floor using a nylon stripping pad via a machine or by hand. Pick up the slurry and then rinse floor.
- 5. Rinse the floor with fresh clean water to remove any remaining residue.
- 6. Neutralise the floor with a 50:50 solution of vinegar and water and allow to air dry.
